Lodge Heating Information

All G lodges and T3, T4, T6 & T7

- Lounge, dining area along with hallways have airflow heaters that are very controllable start heating as soon as they are switched on.
- Switch heater on at the wall then using the up and down arrow on the display on the side of the heater set to the required temperature.
- All bedrooms have convector heaters which require to be switched on at the wall then use the sliding glider to obtain the heat required for the room, heater can be switched on an off at the wall as required by the guest

3 Bedroom T lodges

- Underfloor heating upstairs which is controlled by thermostats on the wall.
- There is also a wall heater/fire in the lounge area that can be used the controls for this are on the bottom righthand side of the heater/fire
- All bedrooms have convector heaters which require to be switched on at the wall then use the sliding glider to obtain the heat required for the room, heater can be switched on an off at the wall as required by the guest

T11

- Underfloor heating through out with each area having its own thermostat on the wall, which guests can control to suit their needs.
- There is also a wall heater/fire in the lounge area that can be used the controls for this are on the bottom righthand side of the heater/fire
